

## Grade Four Bible

You will be embarking on a wonderful journey this year as your child's understanding of God expands further, and they are able to have a deeper relationship with God. The Bob Jones University Press Bible Truths 4: God and His People encourages the habit of daily Bible reading and application of biblical knowledge to everyday living. This chronological and thematic study of the Bible begins with Moses and includes the attributes of God, Bible study, prayer, and the miracles of Christ. The student will also learn about Christian graces and promises of Christ to His followers. Lessons feature Bible study skills, hymn stories, and heroes of church history. Two additional novels are included to supplement these studies: *Captive Treasure* and *With Daring Faith*. The student workbook can stand on its own, but it is recommended to also purchase the teachers guide which provides more activities and directions for the worktext. It will also have scheduled the supplementary novels. If you chose not to order the teachers edition, you will need to schedule into your year when to read the novels. It is also recommended at this grade level that you purchase the tests as well. Please have your child complete the tests, and submit them to your teacher graded.

The discipline of devotions is very important for children to learn. To emphasize what your child will be learning in *God and His People* you will want to model devotions in your family life with family devotions. We highly recommend using ASCI "KID Time" Prayer guide (Kids Interceding Daily) made available at their website: <http://www.acsi.org/web2003/default.aspx?ID=2037> There is a sample included in this manual for your perusal. The prayer guide has a focus each month on a missionary and related prayer points for every day. There are also extension activities included on the website. If you wish, this can be used as a sample for your teacher, as you can hand in the prayer calendar with checkmarks on days that have been completed.

Scripture memory is also a very important part of our Bible program. We suggest that during your devotions or morning exercises you encourage your child to recite the weekly memory verse. Make scripture memory fun! Play many memory games as you go about the day and make connections for your child about what they are memorizing and their daily life. There is a suggested list of verses on a checklist with this manual. As your child memorizes each one, check it off and you can submit the form to your teacher when requested.
